Culver City Great Parks was founded to help Culver City improve our parks through citizen awareness, action and fundraising.

Who We Are: The Culver City Great Parks Association (CCGP) is a community based fund-raising organization whose mission is to improve the physical appearance and functionality of our parks. CCGP is an IRS-approved 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization 95-4858767. For about a year now, we have been quietly working on organizing CCGP, getting IRS approval and finding needed volunteers.

Mission: It is our intention to better the environment of the parks beginning with public interest and input, without straining the city budget. While we will not refuse financial assistance from the city, it is our goal to fund each project through federal and state grants, public and private donations, and organized fundraisers.

Community: With community involvement, from design, to budget, to completion, it is our belief that we will enhance our parks in a way that the residents of Culver City expect: in harmony with the neighborhoods that the parks serve.

Park Neighborhoods: CCGP will be encouraging your active participation in helping to create "Friends of Parks" groups to become actively involved with each of Culver City's parks and, perhaps even, the developing California State Park.

Blair Hills Park, Blanco Park, Carlson Park, Coombs Park, Culver City Park, Culver West Richard Alexander Park, El Marino Park, Fox Hills Park, Heritage Park, Lindberg Park, Media Park, Syd Kronethal Park, Tellefson Park and Veterans Memorial Park.

New Parks Master Plan: The City of Culver City is working on creating a new Parks & Recreation master plan. The existing Culver City Parks master plan dates from 1968. The planning process starts with a survey (or inventory) of the existing resources and services in our current parks, playgrounds & public facilities. Then the planning process and public hearings consider what park & recreational facilities and services that Culver City wants and should have to serve our residents and, more importantly, our families. The public hearing process will be starting in the coming months. CCGP will be encouraging your participation in helping to create a new Parks & Recreation Master Plan for all of Culver City.

Great Fiesta Fundraiser: We received \$855 in donations over the Fiesta. We had over 30 people sign our volunteer sheet. People were asked to sign up, no matter what level of commitment they thought they could give. Most importantly, we had a presence at the Fiesta. People now know that we exist, and what we want to do. There were a lot of great questions asked, and many compliments on the CCGP mission.
